All of Trousdale County, Tennessee and tracts 205.01, 205.02, 205.03, 206.01, 206.02, 206.03, 207.00, 208.00, 209.01, 209.03, 209.04, 209.05, 210.02, 210.05, 210.06, 210.07, 210.08, 210.09, 211.03, 211.04, 211.05, 211.06, 211.07, 212.01, 212.03, 212.04, and 212.05 of Sumner County, Tennessee. SERVICES OFFERED BY BRANCHES

Paragould:

Downtown Office in Paragould:

The Downtown office in Paragould is the headquarters for First National Bank. Located in what is considered the "old" part of Paragould, the presence of FNB in this area is a significant anchor for bringing people back to the historic section of Paragould. This location is great for customers because of its convenient location across the street from the Post Office and just a block away from the Paragould City Hall and the Greene County Courthouse. This office offers full-service banking including loans, deposit

services, safe deposit box rental, cashier's checks, money orders, redeems savings bonds, ATM and debit cards, wire transfer services, and more. A depository walk-up ATM is located in the outer lobby. The lobby hours are 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Monday through Friday, and 8:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. on Saturdays. Our downtown drive through is located across the street in the service and support building. The drive through has five lanes and a drive-up ATM. Hours are 7:30 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Monday through Wednesday and 7:30 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. on Thursdays and Fridays, as well as 8:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. on Saturday. The Downtown office also has two night depository units; one in the main building and another in the drive through facility. We have bi-lingual employees available at this branch for our Hispanic customers.

West Branch in Paragould:

The West Branch office is located at 201 Linwood Drive (U.S. Hwy 49) just 2 blocks north of Kingshighway (U.S. Hwy 412), the main thoroughfare of Paragould. The intersection of these two major highways virtually divides Paragould into four quadrants; thus making this office convenient for any part of the community. All types of teller transactions may be conducted at this office, either at one of the three teller windows inside the lobby, or in one of the three drive through lanes. This branch is also equipped with a drive-up ATM and a night depository. West Branch lobby hours are 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Monday through Friday; the drive through is open 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Monday through Thursday and 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. on Fridays. Safe deposit box rental is not available at this location.

Reynolds Road in Paragould:

Located at 2701 W. Kingshighway and Reynolds Road this office is in a growing section of Paragould. A staff of nine employees includes a loan officer and new accounts personnel making this a full-service bank. Teller transactions may be conducted in the lobby or in the five drive through lanes. A drive-up ATM and night depository are also located at this branch. Lobby hours are 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Monday through Friday, and 8:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. on Saturday mornings. The drive through hours are 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Monday through Thursday, 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. on Fridays, and 8:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. on Saturdays. Safe deposit box rental is not available at this location.

Jonesboro:

Hilltop in Jonesboro:

This structure was replaced in January of 2019 on property located directly behind the original building. The original office opened in September of 1998 and was the first FNB branch in

Craighead County. The building is still located in Northeast Arkansas at 3500 East Johnson Avenue, at the intersection of US 49 and Arkansas Highway 351. This branch offers full-service banking with multiple loan officers, three new account representatives, and several tellers. Services provided include loans, account openings, safe deposit boxes, redeems savings bonds, money orders, cashier's checks, and all other new account services. This branch has lobby tellers, drive-up teller lanes, and drive-up ATM. Hilltop drive-through hours are 7:30 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. Monday through Friday, and 8:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. on Saturdays. Lobby hours are 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Monday through Friday and 8:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. on Saturdays. This branch also features a Community Room available for rent for businesses and non-profit organizations.

Elk Park in Jonesboro:

This office opened in October of 2001, and it is located at 912 Southwest Drive near the intersection of Interstate 555. This branch offers full-service banking with three new account officers, and four tellers. Services provided include account openings, safe deposit boxes, redeems savings bonds, money orders, cashier's checks, and all other new account services. This branch has lobby tellers, drive-up teller lanes, and drive-up ATM. Elk Park drive-through hours are 8:00 am to 5:00 pm Monday through Thursday, 8:00 am to 6:00 pm on Fridays, and 8:00 am to 12:00 pm on Saturdays. Lobby hours are 8:00 am to 5:00 pm Monday through Friday. We have a bilingual teller at this branch for our Hispanic customers.

Highland in Jonesboro:

This office opened in October of 2005. It is our newest branch in Craighead County, and it is located at 2701 East Highland Drive. This branch offers full-service deposit banking with three new account officers and six tellers. There is no loan officer at this branch. Services provided include account openings, safe deposit boxes, redeems savings bonds, money orders, cashier's checks, and all other new account services. This branch has lobby tellers, drive-up teller lanes, and drive-up ATM. Highland drive-through hours are 7:30 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. Monday through Friday and 8:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. on Saturdays. Lobby hours are 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Monday through Friday.

Corning:

Corning Banking Center in Corning:

This branch offers full-service banking including the availability of 2 loan officers. Services include loans, deposits, safe deposit, cashiers' checks, money orders, redeems savings bonds, ATM and debit cards, wire transfer services, etc. Lobby and drive through hours for this branch are 8:00 to 5:00 Monday through Friday and 8:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. on Saturdays. Saturday hours are teller service only. The drive-through features four lanes including a drive-up ATM.

Piggott:

Piggott Banking Center:

This branch located at 635 E. Main, Piggott, offers full-service banking including the availability of 2 loan officers. Services include loans, deposits, safe deposit, cashier's checks, money orders, redeems savings bonds, ATM and debit cards, wire transfer services, etc. Lobby and drive through hours for this branch are 8:00 to 5:00 Monday through Friday and 8:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. on Saturdays. The drive-through features four lanes including a drive-up ATM.

Central:

Heber Springs Branch:

This branch opened December 1, 2014 and is located at 1324 Highway 25B North, Heber Springs, AR. Services include loans, deposits, safe deposit, cashier's checks, money orders, redeems savings bonds, ATM and debit cards, wire transfer services, etc. Lobby and drive through hours for this branch are 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Monday through Friday. Branch is open lobby and drive through from 8:00 a.m. to 12 p.m. on Saturdays. The drive-through features four lanes including a drive-up ATM.

Downtown Office in Little Rock:

The Downtown office in Little Rock is the headquarters for First National Bank in Central Arkansas. We are located at 300 West Capitol Ave., just blocks away from the State Capitol. This office offers full-service banking including loans, deposit services, safe deposit box rental, cashier's checks, money orders, redeems savings bonds, ATM and debit cards, wire transfer services, and more. The lobby hours are 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Monday through Friday. The drive-through has four lanes and a walk-up ATM.

Baptist Hospital Branch in Little Rock:

The Baptist Branch office is located at 9601 Baptist Health Drive STE 103 Little Rock, AR 72205, in the base of the medical tower. The Branch is located on the campus of one of the three large hospitals in the city, making this office convenient for any part of the community. All types of teller transactions may be conducted at this office, either at one of the three teller windows inside the lobby. This branch is also equipped with a walk-up ATM and a night depository. Baptist Branch lobby hours are 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Monday through Friday. Safe deposit box rental is available at this location.

Chenal Parkway branch in Little Rock:

Located at 15721 Chenal Parkway this office is in a growing section of Little Rock. A staff of 7 employees includes the Mortgage loan Department and new accounts personnel making this a full-service bank. Teller transactions may be conducted in the lobby or in the two drive through lanes. A drive-up ATM and night depository are also located at this branch. Lobby hours are 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Monday through Friday. The drive through hours are 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Monday through Thursday, 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. on Fridays. Safe deposit box rental is available at this location. We have a bilingual teller at this branch.

Rodney Parham branch in Little Rock:

Located at 11101 Rodney Parham this office is in a mature section of Little Rock. A staff of 5 employees includes CSR and new accounts personnel making this a full-service bank. Teller transactions may be conducted in the lobby or in the two drive through lanes. A drive-up depository ATM and night depository are also located at this branch. Lobby hours are 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Monday through Friday. The drive through hours are 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Monday through Thursday, 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. on Fridays. The Branch is open from 8:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. on Saturdays. Safe deposit box rental is available at this location. We have a bilingual teller at this branch.

Kavanaugh branch in Little Rock:

Located at 5601 Kavanaugh, this office is in a mature section of Little Rock. A staff of 6 employees includes a Loan Officer and assistant, CSR and new accounts personnel making this a full-service bank. Teller transactions may be conducted in the lobby or in the two drive through lanes. A drive-up depository ATM and night depository are also located at this branch. Lobby hours are 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Monday through Friday. The drive through hours are 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Monday through Thursday, 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. on Fridays. Safe deposit box rental is available at this location.

North Little Rock:

Lakewood branch in North Little Rock:

Located at 4845 North Hills Blvd. This office is in a mature section of North Little Rock. A staff of 4 employees includes CSR and new accounts personnel making this a full-service bank. Teller transactions may be conducted in the lobby or in the two drive through lanes. A drive-up ATM and night depository are also located at this branch. Lobby hours are 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Monday through Friday. The drive through hours are 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Monday through Thursday, 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. on Fridays. Safe deposit box rental is available at this location.

Northwest Arkansas:

Rogers Branch:

This branch opened November 12, 2014 and is located at 3701 S. Pinnacle Hills Pkwy, Rogers AR. Services include loans, deposits, safe deposit, cashier's checks, money orders, redeems savings bonds, ATM and debit cards, wire transfer services, etc. Lobby and drive through hours for this branch are 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Monday through Friday. The drive-through features four lanes and a drive-up ATM lane. We have a bilingual loan officer and tellers at this branch for our Hispanic customers.

Bentonville Branch:

This branch opened February 17, 2015 and is located at 300 SE Walton Blvd., Bentonville AR. Services include loans, deposits, safe deposit, cashier's checks, money orders, redeems savings bonds, ATM and debit cards, wire transfer services, etc. Lobby and drive through hours for this branch are 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Monday through Friday. The drive-through features four lanes and a drive-up ATM lane.

Fayetteville Branch:

This branch opened May 15, 2015 and is located at 2691 E. Mission Blvd, Fayetteville, AR. Services include loans, deposits, safe deposit, cashier's checks, money orders, redeems savings bonds, ATM and debit cards, wire transfer services, etc. Lobby and drive through hours for this branch are 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Monday through Friday. The drive-through features four lanes and a drive-up ATM lane.

Springdale Branch:

This branch opened on August 24, 2015 and is located at 1950 S. Pleasant St., Springdale, AR. Services include loans, deposits, safe deposit, cashier's checks, money orders, redeems savings bonds, ATM and debit cards, wire transfer services, etc. Lobby and drive through hours for this branch are 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Monday through Friday. The drive-through features four lanes and a drive-up ATM lane. We have a bilingual CSR/Teller at this branch for our Hispanic customers.

Springdale-Johnson Branch:

This branch opened October 26, 2015 and is located at 4000 Johnson Mill Blvd., Springdale, AR. Services include loans, deposits, safe deposit, cashier's checks, money orders, redeem savings bonds, ATM and debit cards, wire transfer services, etc. Lobby and drive through hours for this branch are 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Monday through Friday. The drive-through features four lanes and a drive-up ATM lane.

Tennessee:

Harstville Branch:

This branch was opened August of 1905 and is located at 100 McMurry Blvd., Hartsville, TN. Services include loans, deposits, safe deposit boxes, cashier's checks, money orders, redeem savings bonds, ATM and debit cards, wire transfers. There are two drive-through lanes, a night depository, and an ATM lane at this branch. Lobby hours are Monday through Thursday 8:30am to 4:00pm and 8:30am to 5:00pm on Fridays.

Drive-through is open Monday through Thursday 8:30am to 4:30pm and 8:30am to 6pm on Fridays. Both lobby and drive-through are open Saturdays 8:30am to noon.

Gallatin Branch:

This branch opened in August of 2003 and is located at 150 W. Main St, Gallatin, TN. Services include loans, deposits, safe deposit boxes, cashier's checks, money orders, redeem savings bonds, ATM and debit cards, wire transfers. There are two drivethrough lanes, a night depository, and an ATM lane at this branch. Lobby hours are Monday through Thursday 8:30am to 4:00pm and Fridays 8:30am to 5:00pm. Drive through is open Monday through Thursday 8:00am to 5:00pm and Fridays from 8:00am to 6:00pm.

Hendersonville Branch:

This branch opened in April of 2017 and is located at 100 Cinema Dr, Hendersonvillle, TN. Services include loans, deposits, cashier's checks, money orders, redeem savings bonds, ATM and debit cards, wire transfers. There are two drive-through lanes, a night depository, and an ATM lane at this branch. Lobby is open Monday through Thursday 8:30am to 4:00pm and Friday 8:30am to 5:00pm. Drive through is open Monday through Friday 8:00am to 5:00pm.

SERVICES OFFERED BANKWIDE:

"Same-day-credit" is a positive feature that First National Bank accountholders enjoy. Deposits made during regular business hours, Monday through Friday with the exception of Federal holidays, are considered deposited on that date. This allows our customers more time to make deposits and receive same day credit on their funds; a real plus for those who work in the manufacturing segment of our communities.

Alternative Banking Services

Bank-By-Mail: The bank-by-mail method is an alternative way of banking for individuals who are unable to come into our branches. This service is available to all of our customers at no additional charge. The bank provides postage paid business reply envelopes with which the customer may mail in their deposits. Once the item is received and processed by bank personnel, the customer is then mailed a receipt.

Electronic banking services allow our customers to access their bank accounts in many different ways and from various venues. These services reduce the customer's dependency on traditional "brick and mortar" offices. Services include automatic teller machines (ATM), telephone banking systems, and internet banking systems. Even

though there are considerable costs absorbed by the bank in order to provide these conveniences, these electronic banking services are available at no cost to the customer. The following summarizes our various electronic banking services.

Automatic Teller Machines. First National Bank has 29 ATMs that are available to the public 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. Two of these ATMs are in the distressed area of Clay county. In addition to the machines mentioned above in the branch descriptions, FNB also maintains an ATM in the lobby of Arkansas Methodist Hospital in Paragould, Highway 10 in Little Rock, Foxcroft in Little Rock, TAC Air airport in Little Rock, Dickey Stephens Ballpark in North Little Rock, and Heights Grocery in Little Rock.

First National Bank does not charge a fee for issuing an ATM card or VISA debit card. There are no monthly service charges, and we do not charge our customers transaction fees for using their ATM cards at any of our machines. Point of sale transactions are also handled at no charge. If a customer uses their ATM card at a machine owned by another institution there is a \$1 fee per transaction. FNB is a member of two ATM network systems. The PLUS and PULSE ATM networks allow customers to access their accounts worldwide for withdrawals and transfers of funds. Our ATMs are also part of the QUEST ATM system which allows recipients of government benefits to use their Electronic Benefits Transactions cards to access their cash benefits. The EBT cardholder need not be an account holder of FNB to be able to access their benefits and is not charged a fee for this service. In 2005, First National Bank purchased the equipment necessary to add the availability of postage stamps at our ATMs. A customer may purchase a sheet of eighteen postage stamps with their ATM, debit, or credit card.

Telephone and Internet Banking. Since 1997, First National Bank has offered free telephone banking, "*PhoneFirst*", which allows customers 24-hour access to their account information. The system requires accountholders to verify their identity with the use of a personal identification number to prevent unauthorized access.

In 1999, FNB began offering free internet banking to its customers, allowing customers to access their account information from anywhere in the world. "NetTeller" service gives customers account information, the ability to transfer funds, or make loan payments.

For our customers who enjoy the benefits of "NetTeller", we offer an additional bill pay service. There is no monthly fee for this service, with only minimal charges after the first twenty-five payments a month.

Mobile App. We have made enhancements to our App for everyday banking needs to be accomplished using a smart phone. A NetTeller customer may use their smart phone to check their balance, transfer funds between accounts, pay bills (if a bill pay customer), deposit checks, view transactions, and chat with

employees. There is no charge for this service although the customer is required to have a data plan with their phone service provider.

Live Chat. Customers are now able to chat with an employee of First National Bank both online, or through their First National Bank app. If customers have questions regarding a specific transaction, they have the ability to attach the transaction in question to the chat. Live Chat is available Monday through Friday from 8 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.

Remote Deposit Capture. Commercial Customers. Customers can scan their deposits through a batch processing machine which encrypts the information and automatically sends information to us to process the deposit.

ACH Origination/Direct Deposit. Commercial Customers. Customers import or create files in netteller. The information is encrypted. The ACH department checks totals for verification.

Lending

We understand that lending plays a critical role in the economic growth and development of our communities. It is the intention of First National Bank to make credit available to all creditworthy customers of our assessment areas by applying fair lending practices and policies. Our loan policy provides the guidelines for these extensions of credit and prohibits discriminatory practices.

First National Bank also has relationships with local businesses where we make "dealer loans". These dealer relationships allow us to reach a broader range of customers, including individuals who might not ordinarily use the services we provide.

DEPOSIT SERVICES

Since 1995, FNB has offered free checking to the people of our community. These accounts are the most popular type of account opened at First National Bank. There is no monthly service charge and no minimum balance requirement; allowing more individuals the opportunity to use banking services. First National also offers a savings account that may be opened with a deposit of \$10 and may be maintained with a low minimum balance of \$10. There is a quarterly service charge of \$3 for accounts falling below the minimum balance; a minor amount for this type of account. We feel that our free checking and our savings accounts reach a portion of the community which would otherwise not be served.

First National does not charge a fee for cashing local payroll checks and most government issued checks (the exception being income tax refunds). We also do free cash advances from electronic benefit cards such as unemployment benefit cards.

Other Services

Utility Bill Payments. Customers of Paragould City Light & Water, Entergy, Centerpoint, and Allegiance Cable formerly Cox Cable may pay their bills at a First National Bank teller window at no additional charge. This service is greatly used in our Paragould and Corning branches. First National Bank also offers brochures in Spanish for our Spanish-speaking customers. First National Bank has a dedicated team of Retail Bankers for our business customers.
